Re: Chamber of Commerce Whistleblower Letter

Dear Special Agent in Charge:

I am the attorney, spokesman and board member for Velvet Revolution, a national non-profit dedicated to corporate and government accountability. Last year, we launched a campaign called StopTheChamber.com, to expose unethical and criminal activity at the U.S. Chamber of Commerce. I am enclosing two of our previous letters to you seeking criminal investigations based on other information.

In December 2009, we offered a reward for information about criminal activity by Chamber CEO Tom Donohue. Last month, we re-offered that reward and put out a press release about it. Within 24 hours, the Chamber's attorneys contacted PR Newswire and demanded that it remove the press release from the Internet, and PR Newswire complied. Other outlets still host the release. I am including a copy of that press release. Also, last month, the Washington Monthly magazine released a profile on Mr. Donohue entitled, "Show Him The Money, Tom Donohue scares millions of dollars out of corporations and Republicans. But is his U.S. Chamber of Commerce good for business?" I am enclosing a copy.


On August 4, 2010, we received a letter from a purported Chamber of Commerce insider in response to our latest reward offer. See enclosed. In short, the insider compares Tom Donohue to Jack Abramoff, Michael Scanlon and Bernie Maddoff, in the manner in which he is scamming clients to serve his own interests rather than the interests of the business community. He alleges fraud, campaign finance violations and financial impropriety that could be uncovered with a criminal investigation. Equally troubling, he alleges that Mr. Donohue does not fear the FEC or Congress and has a plan in place to attack the Department of Justice if the DOJ investigates him. He also says that the DOJ is the only thing Mr. Donohue fears.

We again urge the FBI and DOJ to conduct an investigation into the activities of Tom Donohue and the Chamber. Based on this and other information, there are strong indications that the Chamber, in collaboration with Karl Rove's new 527 group, American Crossroads, plans to manipulate the upcoming elections by violating campaign finance laws, fraudulently inducing companies to fund these activities, and corrupting the election results. We would like to meet with you to share other information we have received that supports our belief.

In conclusion, we ask that the DOJ create a task force to deal with this issue. As the insider noted, Tom Donohue does not fear the Federal Election Commission because it "has no power" to enforce the law. Therefore, it falls on the DOJ itself to create a mechanism to investigate and

prosecute criminal violations by the Chamber and other groups that plan to raise and spend record amounts of money to target specific candidates.
